What's allowed under level 1 water restrictions:

You can use drinking water to:

- clean animals and birds using a bucket and sponge, a hand-held hose with a trigger nozzle if required or professional animal wash service
- clean animal pens/yards/cages using a bucket, hand-held hose fitted with a trigger nozzle or high-pressure cleaning equipment
- cool an enclosure (sheds or similar) using dedicated sprinklers, only between 6 am and 9 pm when the temperature inside the enclosure is greater than 30° C
- operate fogging or misting systems and cooling pads at any time in accordance with regulatory requirements for your industry.

Exemptions

If you can't comply with the restrictions, you'll need to apply for an exemption permit via at sydneywater.com.au/exemptions.
