## Boats/jet skis

### Under level 1 water restrictions:

You can use drinking water to:

- wash vessels and/or trailers using a bucket and sponge, hand-held hose fitted with a trigger nozzle, high-pressure cleaning equipment or at a commercial wash facility
- flush the motor of a boat or other vessel with:
  - a suitable container filled by a hand-held hose fitted with a trigger nozzle
  - a purpose-designed flushing device connected to a hose. The water must be turned off immediately after the flushing is complete
- clean bilges and safety components of boat trailers (wheel bearing / brakes) with high pressure cleaning equipment or a hand-held hose fitted with a trigger nozzle
- fill water tanks on a boat using a hose, as long as you don't leave the hose unattended or allow the tank to overflow
- rinse vessels after use in salt water for 10 minutes using a hand-held hose fitted with a trigger nozzle at a public boat ramp.

**Hoses at boat ramps must be fitted with trigger nozzles and connected to a timer that shuts off the water after 10 minutes. This is the responsibility of the boat ramp owner.**
